No. 4836 L.R.- 2nd April, 1956 - In exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the East Bengal State Acquisition and Tenancy Act, 1950 (East Bengal Act No. XXVIII of 1951), as amended by the East Bengal State Acquisition and Tenancy (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956 (East Bengal Ordinance No. III of 1956), it is hereby notified for the information of all concerned that the Governor is pleased to acquire, with effect from the 14th April, 1956, all interests of all rent-receivers in their respective estates, taluks, tenures, holdings and tenancies situated in the district of Dacca, including their interests in all sub-soil and rights to minerals in such estates, taluks, tenures, holdings and tenancies, except the interests and rights which have already been acquired by, and have already vested in, the Provincial Government under the provisions of the said Act.
